UNIT GOALS

- Document exploration of ideas and maintain a record of how they develop in a visual diary/sketchbook
- Describe how art elements and principles, media, material, skills and techniques are used in their own and others' art works (8.6)
- Use appropriate arts language and refer to specific examples in written work (8.6)
- Show awareness of and discuss a range of historical and cultural examples of art works
- Interpret and discuss ways that their own art and others art works communicate ideas (8.7)
