

IB DIPLOMA RESULTS 2021 – JAKARTA CAMPUS

Congratulations to all our IB Diploma Programme students for achieving a 100% success rate - all 10 students who attempted this challenging programme were awarded the IB Diploma! Following are the summary statistics for the IB Diploma Programme, November 2021 session. This is our sixth cohort and once again we have achieved a 100% success rate. This is even more remarkable given our context. AIS Indonesia does not discriminate against students wishing to attempt the full Diploma. While counselling of students takes place throughout the two years of the programme, students who wish to attempt subjects in the Diploma are supported to do so. Realistic predicted grades provided by the subject teachers are supplied to parents and students at various points in the programme and support the counselling process. In addition, three of our students pursued Group 1 studies in their mother tongue language of Korean and consequently achieved a Bilingual Diploma, having studied the rest of their subjects in English.

Congratulations to both **Yovela Budiman and Putu Anindya (Indy) Wardhana** who are our joint school Duxes for 2021, each of whom achieved the **maximum IB score of 45, an ATAR equivalent of 99.95** (also the maximum possible). In other years, Karl Devlin Chau's score of 42 (ATAR 99.10) would have seen him top the IB scores for AIS, so again congratulations Devlin. Both Indy and Yovela have accepted **full academic scholarships** to the University of Melbourne. What a fantastic achievement.

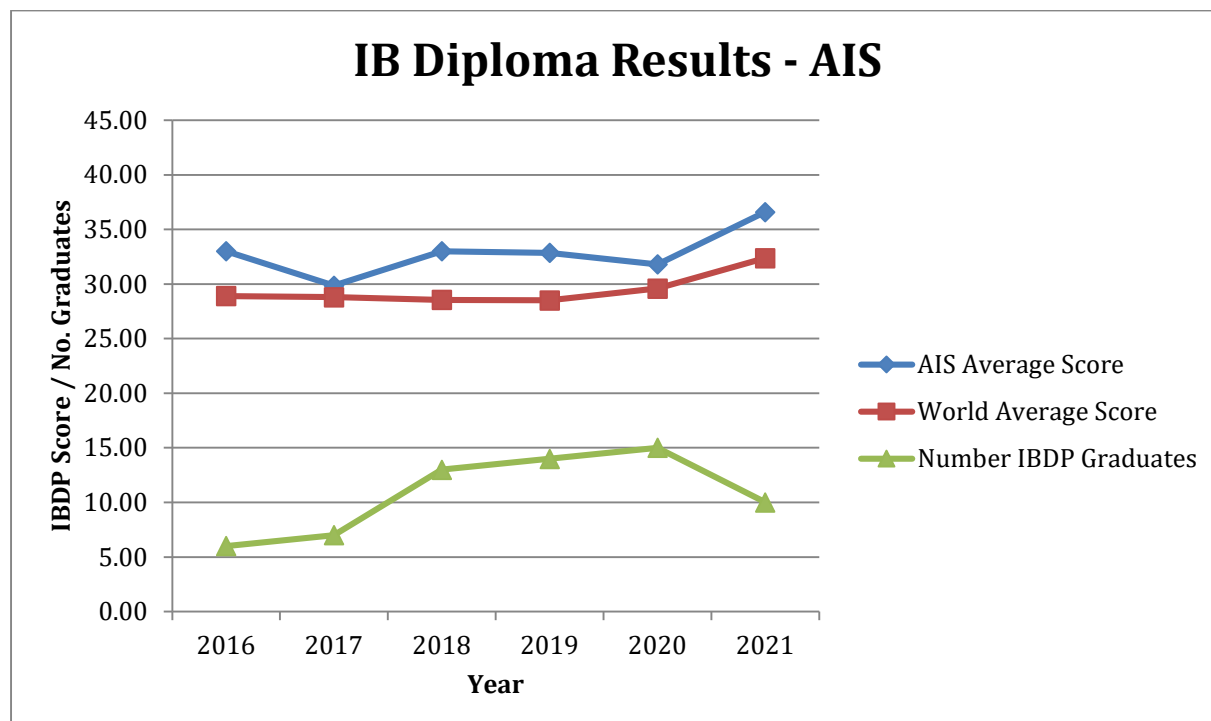

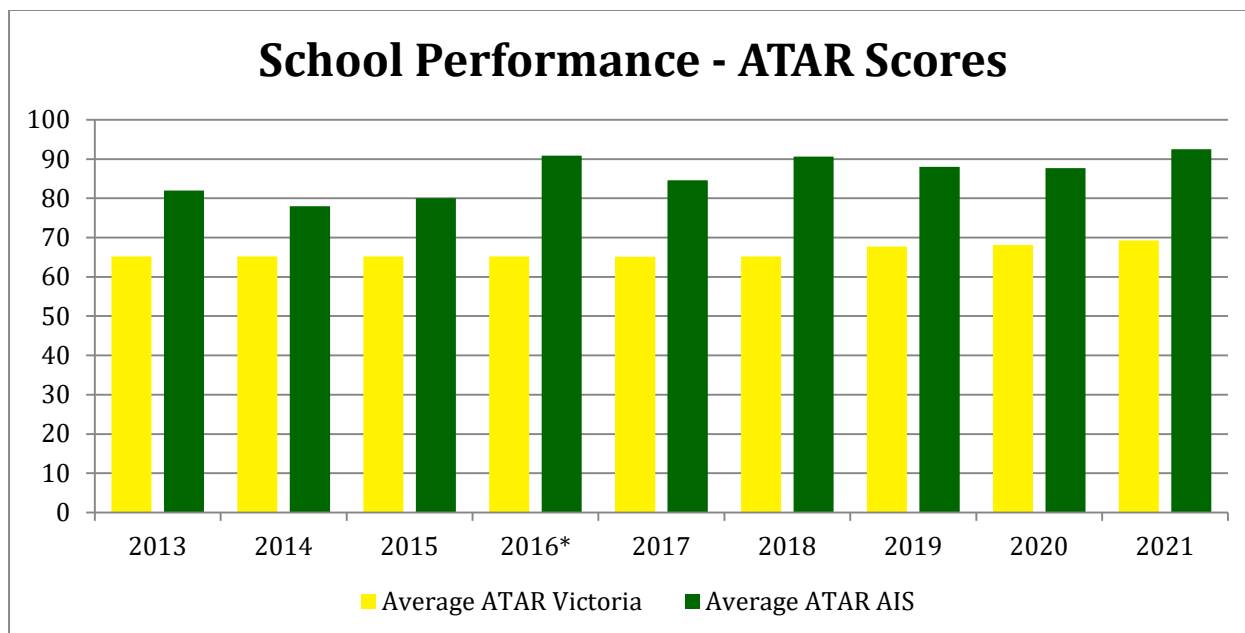
